Life Skills is ACE at Astley because:

We equip the children with the knowledge and confidence so they will be able to make the correct life choices. Topics are carefully chosen to meet the objectives of the compulsory health education, relationships education and relationships and sex education (RSE) as well as covering additional objectives and learning opportunities recommended by the PSHE association. Research into national data and pupil consultation helped chose these.

We foster a supportive and caring learning environment where children feel safe to discuss their worries and concerns. Curriculum enrichment is embedded across the year groups with focus days and visits and trips.

Life Skills is progressive at Astley because:

The curriculum has been carefully mapped to reflect a spiral curriculum. Our new resource to cover the statutory requirements for teaching RSE has a scheme of work for each year group. The six strands: My Feelings, My Body, My Relationships, My Beliefs, My Rights and Responsibilities and Asking for Help are all covered each year in which knowledge, values and skills develop and build upon previous learning

Other topics have been mapped out across the key stages. Topics are introduced in Key Stage 1 and are recapped and developed with age appropriate objectives in Key Stage 2. Where possible links have been made between topics within Year groups.
