Reading and Homework:

Bringing their reading folder to school every day enables your child to read to adults within school. Reading records will be checked and reading prizes awarded, where possible, on **Wednesdays** and library books will be changed on the same day.

PE:

PE is now timetabled for **Mondays and Fridays**. Your child should come to school in their PE kit on these days. **Forest School** is timetabled for **Tuesday** and **PE kit should be worn for this as well, please**. This should be a plain white or house team coloured t shirt, dark shorts and trainers. There should be no big logos or emblems, and no football kits. Please ensure long hair is tied back and earrings are removed on these days. On colder days you may want your child to wear a warmer top and tracksuit bottoms. On Wednesdays and Thursdays your child should come into school in normal school uniform.
