### What your child needs to bring:

Your child should come in school uniform unless it is their PE day (see PE section for further information on this). There will be a hot dinner, jacket potato and a packed lunch option available but if your child would prefer a packed lunch from home, please send them in with this.

Children are encouraged to bring a water bottle into school, and a coat. Please ensure your child's bottle and coat is named. Please note that children do not need to bring a pencil case, as school is able to provide everything your child with need.

**PE:**

PE is timetabled for a **Tuesday and Wednesday**. Your child should come to school in their PE kit on these days. This should be a plain white or house team coloured t shirt, dark shorts, and trainers. There should be no big logos or emblems, and no football kits. Please ensure long hair is tied back and earrings are removed on these days. On colder days you may want your child to wear a warmer top and tracksuit bottom over the top.

**Reading and Homework:**

As per our homework policy, children will receive a reading book of their choice and their corresponding Read. Write. Inc or book band book every Wednesday alongside a spelling and times table worksheet. These should be completed and handed in for the following Wednesday. Children will receive house point and reading prizes for completing. In addition to this, children need to bring their reading folders with them every day.
